

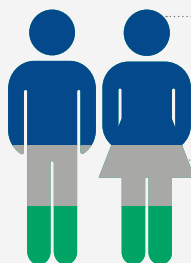


/ INCOMING FOREIGN STUDENTS

Foreign students spending a period of study in the region fell to around 450 in 2019/2020 from 600 in the previous year. These lower numbers (-25%) can be explained by the pandemic that began right in the second semester of the academic year.

Data on the countries of origin of incoming students were stable. As in previous years, most were European citizens enrolled on courses at Human Sciences and Social Sciences departments.
