

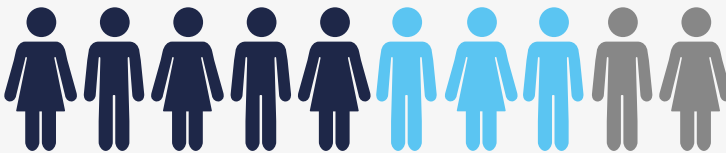


/ OUTGOING TEACHING STAFF AND RESEARCHERS

As is to be expected following the figures for incoming staff, the number of outgoing researchers and teaching staff also continued to feel the effects of the pandemic. Data for trips abroad remained in line with the previous year, dropping slightly from 34 to 31 in 2021. Before the pandemic, the number of trips stood at 93. The main destinations were still

EU countries and North America. The profile of those travelling abroad did, however, alter in part. Despite the majority (58%) still being accounted for by researchers and teachers of Mathematics, Physics, ICT, Engineering, and Universe and Earth Sciences, in 2021, those representing the Human and Social Sciences more than doubled, jumping from 15% to 32%.
